Bailee Stachkhose, 3, of Spring Valley, MN was diagnosed with stage IV kidney cancer in January 2021. Her treatment includes radiation, chemotherapy, and multiple surgeries. Her right kidney was removed in March along with a large abdominal tumor. She continues to have outpatient and inpatient chemo to remove the numerous tumors from the lungs and lymph nodes.



Lillian Johannes, 8, of Sauk Rapids, MN was diagnosed in the winter of 2019 with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL). Lillian did great throughout her chemotherapy treatments with very little disruption to her life until February 2021, with just 35 days left of treatment, her family found out Lillian had relapsed and was diagnosed with relapsed ALL of the central nervous system (CNS). With this diagnosis comes a completely different treatment plan. Lillian and her mother traveled to Philadelphia for six weeks to receive CAR-T treatment along with trips every 3 months.
